ASSE Launches New Program to Help Members Seeking Employment

Fulbright Scholarship Awarded

Dr. Syrulwa Somah has been awarded the prestigious Fulbright Scholar grant to lecture and conduct research in India. He is among 800 U.S. faculty and professionals who are traveling this academic year to some 150 countries through America's flagship international educational exchange activity. Dr. Somah was selected on the basis of academic or professional achievement, demonstrating extraordinary leadership potential in his field. The Award will allow him to conduct six months' research in "Culture-Driven Malaria Control" in the Indian State of Orissa. The project will run from July 1, 2010 through January 1, 2011. During that period, he will also be teaching Environmental Health, Occupational Safety & Health, Occupational Toxicology, Environmental Assessment, Diseases and Re-emerging and Public Health at Shree Sardar Patel University, one of leading seats of higher education, named after its independence leader of India.

Syrulwa Somah, Ph.D was born in Liberia. In 1967, lured by the promise of benefiting from both western and traditional education, from 1967-1979. Dr. Somah was educated at LaGuardia Community College in Long Island, New York (A.A) and at the State University of New York (B.S.). He also has two graduate degrees from Central Michigan University and from the University of Oklahoma. His Ph.D. is from the Union Institute & Universities in Cincinnati, Ohio.

Dr. Somah is an Associate Professor and Graduate Program Coordinator, Environmental Health and Occupational Safety & Health at North Carolina Agricultural & Technical State University, Greensboro, NC. Dr. Somah is also the Executive Director of Liberian History, Education & Development.
